

The **COVID-19 Community Resource Helpline** has received an overwhelming response. As of May 7, the Community Emergency Response Fund at the Charlottesville Area Community Foundation has provided **\$4.56 million** to more than **5,000 households** in need of financial relief because of the pandemic. This relief has reached more than **18,000 people** in our region. The Helpline has served as a stopgap for many households and we are continuing to fulfill outstanding requests.

**Given the demand on the program, the COVID-19 Helpline and online form ceased taking new applications on Friday, May 8, at 5 p.m.**

- If you have submitted an application already, your request will be processed.
- If you have spoken to an operator or filled out the form and have not yet heard back, you will receive a response.

The Helpline's financial support is disbursed through a partnership between the Charlottesville Area Community Foundation, Cville Community Cares, United Way of Greater Charlottesville, City of Charlottesville, and Albemarle County.
